It's memorable only because it was the last of many.

I can't remember a time when Gampy wasn't there to help me continue on when times were hard or to see my accomplishments when I overcame the hurdles. From 9 years old making the "trash-art" doll my Gammy still has proudly displayed, to the 8th grade basketball game where I got my braces stuck in someone's hair, to my high-school graduation, he was relevant and knowledgeable about everything happening in my life.

I've tried rewriting this so many times and each was never lively or fulfilling enough to describe what my Gampy meant to me. I am left with a hole in my heart and a pain that startles me awake when I realize he's not here anymore.


