In his daily walk with Christ, he was well known and respected in the community by so many. Outside of his church work, Alan would refer to himself as Bev's husband or Kim and Jenny's dad. He would take anything apart and try to fix it with the motto, "I can't break anything bad enough that I can't pay someone else to fix it," but he always managed to fix it himself. 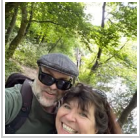
