“A.R. Was my favorite cousin growing up. He was actually my dad’s cousin making him my 2nd cousin. I remember him, as besides being one of my favorite family members, being a steer wrestler, although his steer wrestling career was pretty close to being over when we started hanging around together, and a team roping partner of mine. I remember the time he came without much notice to visit me in Phoenix. I was about 19 or 20, he was probably about 34 or 35, and he came to rope with me for a few days. I have never forgotten the run we made at Dynamite arena, which I think was the home of the Bill Roer Ropathon a year or so earlier, I came out of the box and I heard A.R. Yell “Rope em Bruce!” and somehow caught the best steer that I had ever roped. I’ve roped with a bunch of guys since then including a couple of NFR alumni, and have only heard that hollered at me once. Funny, that’s one of my favorite roping memories of all. Another time, we went to some ropings in Colorado, and me being probably somewhat of a sissy had never eaten Rocky Mountain Oysters. Well, AR was having some at this cafe we were eating at and I had to try them. I didn’t eat anything else for the rest of the week. I truly believe that AR is—was one of the 5 people that I was supposed to meet on my way to Heaven. I love you AR, you’re one of my favorites.
