“ Let me tell you a little about Anne Marie who passed away on June 16, 2020 in Belen, New Mexico and was buried at the Santa Fe National Cemetery. Born in 1948 in Elizabeth, New Jersey, Anne was a “Jersey Girl” earning degrees from two branches of New Jersey’s State University: Douglass College with a Bachelor’s Degree in Russian Studies and a Master’s Degree in Education from Rutgers Graduate School in New Brunswick. She completed doctoral courses in Education, but chose not to take her oral exams. Throughout college, she worked part-time in the United States postal service and would be instrumental in leading local postal workers during the historic postal strike of 1970. Anne would find her passion in helping others through her insurance and financial planning (co-owner of Insurance Planning Association, Inc.) and tax preparation activities (founder of Many Happy Returns). During 23 years of dealing with brain tumors, she would wed and eventually move to New Mexico with her husband, Ed Weizer. Anne Marie is preceded in death by her parents, Alphonse and Irene Bober of Elizabeth, New Jersey. She is survived by her sisters: Margot Toth of Boca Rotan, Florida and Dr. Irene Bober-Moken of San Antonio, Texas. She leaves behind numerous nephews including her godson, James Moken of San Antonio. She valiantly fought brain tumors and her blog provided inspiration to other brain tumor sufferers. Anne was a beautiful person, a family person; she was a painter, a poet and a musician. Her legacy is one of caring and helping those in need. She will be dearly missed!
