Domingo Irenio “Blinky” Romero, 80, returned to God in the early hours of Sunday, 5/16/2021. In spite of being beset with Parkinson’s Disease for many years, Irenio did everything he could to continue enjoying his life and family to the very end. Irenio was preceded in death by his

wife, Dolores; parents, Juan Vicente Romero and Lola Maes; brothers, Clemente and Eduardo and his sisters, Luciana and Margarita. 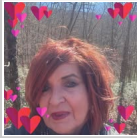

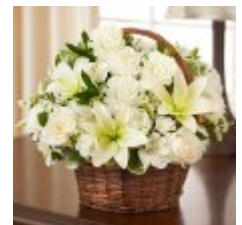
