“ Will and Sandra,

I am beyond words to describe my grief for the untimely death of your beloved son, Dominic. I was fortunate to have been able to work with him and enjoyed the light he brought to days that were dark. He always had a bright smile on his face, and that is exactly how he did his work, with a smile, every day. I can remember conducting interviews for positions we had open at the fire department. He was nervous, poised, sitting straight up, properly dressed, and you could tell he was answering every question genuinely with his heart. He was representing more than himself. It was his family that was fueling his fire to follow the footsteps of his dad.

Dominic always remained positive and would always see the good beyond the bad. In the fire service, we see so much tragedy and grief and on occasion will have a good day filled with temporary happiness. Other fire fighters would also lean on him for advice, or an ear to listen, or a heart to understand. Not one day ever went by that Dominic would show up to work late, unprepared, or moody. He remained an ideal employee with integrity, respect, personal accountability, and love for the career – qualities and traits seldom seen by a new generation of fire personnel. He worked extremely hard and earned everything provided to him. I commented many times that I wish we had 20 Dominic's and our department would be so much better.

He started his career during some trying times in our department. We were transitioning to a new chief, trying to grow our personnel, purchase new trucks and equipment, fighting for the salaries and benefits of our staff, and increase our medical services to the community. He was there every step of the way and always went above and beyond what he was ever asked to do, and more. He always kept busy and would often see me sweeping, mopping, cleaning the trucks, or whatever station duties had to be done. Respectfully interjecting me, he would take the broom or mop and

say "I've got this Chief. I'm sure you have more important things to do."

Some people earn their wings much sooner than others. No one could understand what you are going through, or the path of life God has made for you having lost both of your children, and no words can console. It is the love you have for each other and of your family that will help you along the way in this journey we call life. As Jessica and now Dom are resting in peace, it is us that live in sorrow.
