Georgia Otero-Kirkham, age 67, a resident of El Cerro, New Mexico, passed away unexpectedly on August 28, 2018. She was very active in the community. Georgia was currently the Vice President of the Los Lunas School Board, a member of the Valencia County Hispano Chamber and the UNM-Valencia Development Board. At the time of her passing, she was seeking her third term as a Valencia County Commissioner; having previously served two terms from 2004-2012. Georgia and husband Rex Kirkham, served as owner operators of Fidelity Title, Inc. and later Stewart Title; serving Valencia County for a total of 38 years. She had a true calling as a public servant. Being a deeply devout Catholic, Georgia spent many hours serving Our Lady of Guadalupe Church in Peralta as a member of the Legion of Mary. Georgia was preceded in death by her loving husband J. Rex Kirkham, her parents Manuel Otero, Jr. and Viola B. Otero, her in-laws Jim and Joan Kirkham. She is survived by her two daughters Jennifer (Joseph) Otero, Janel (Bryan) Lowery; brothers Jerry (Madalyn) Otero, Roberto (Gayla) Otero; sisters Pamela (Rocky Hill) Otero, Martha (Tim Welch) Otero; Aunt Ramona Vinson; granddaughters Jocelyn Otero, Justine Otero and Janessa Otero; grandsons Preston Lowery and Parker Lowery; and many caring nieces, nephews and cousins. All Services will take place at Our Lady of Guadalupe Catholic Church in Peralta, NM, beginning with a Public Visitation, Friday August 31,

2018 at 6:00 pm, followed by a Rosary at 7:00 pm. Final Visitation will take place on Saturday September 1, 2018 at 9:00 am with a Funeral Mass to follow at 10:00 am. 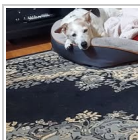
