Gilbert Chavez, a beloved husband, father, grandfather, brother, uncle, nephew, and proud U.S. Air Force retiree, passed away peacefully February 22, 2025 surrounded by his loving family. He was 90 years old.

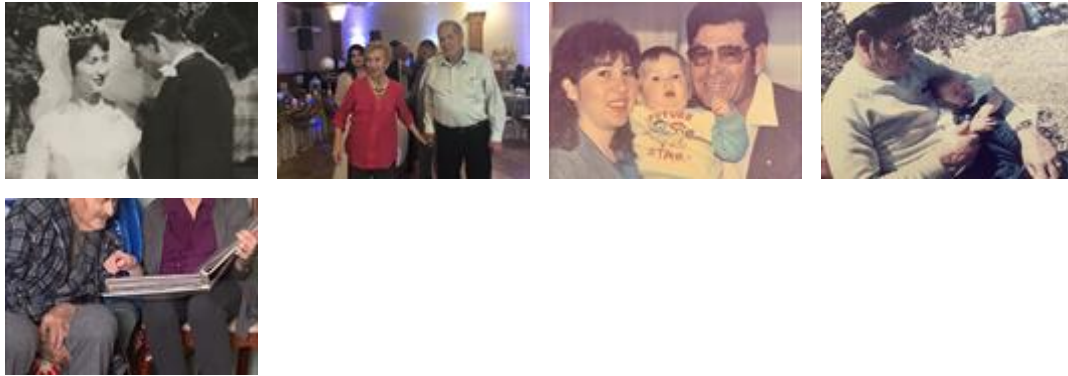
