Gilfred Chavez, age 87, was peacefully welcomed into the embrace of his heavenly Father after a courageous battle with Parkinson's. Gilfred was active in his community. He held office as a Belen Councilman and Mayor Pro-Tem. He loved to sing and was a strong voice in his church choir. Gilfred was instrumental in bringing U of Albuq satellite campus to Rio Grande Estates. Always a visionary, in an era when girls were considered insignificant in sports, he broke a cultural barrier and started a girls AAU track club. He retired from the AT & SF Railroad after 41 years of dedicated service. He was preceded in death by his father, Epifano; mother, Frances; daughter, Priscilla; son, Gilfred; brother, Joe; and sister, Josie Cowper.

He was married for 66 years and is survived by the Dear of his life, Mary Priscilla. They will forever be united by the bond of love that kept them together through the joys and adversities of life.

His legacy lives on in his children, Debbie Leach (Jeff), Wilfred (Dianne), Kathleen (Bill), Patricia Wagy; grandchildren, Eric, Tisha, Matthew and Molly Chavez; and great grandson, Milo. He is also survived by sister, Jennie Lucero and many loving nephews, nieces and godchildren. All services will be held at Our Lady of Belen Catholic Church on Thursday, March 23, 2017. 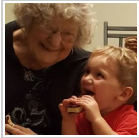

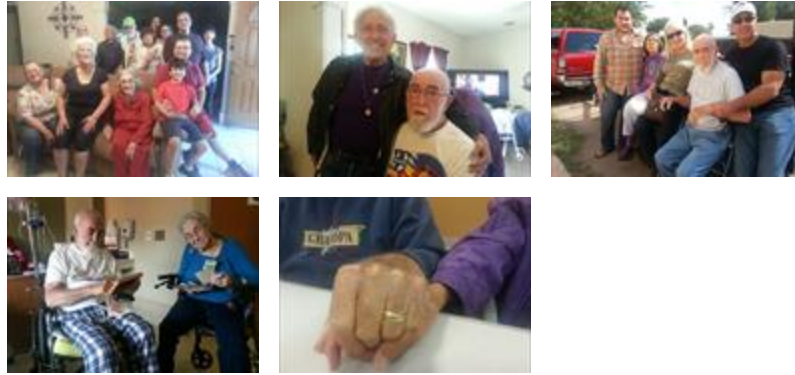
