Herbert Jesse Lloyd Sedillo, age 63, a resident of El Cerro, NM, passed away on Monday, June 24, 2019. He was a graduate of Los Lunas High School in 1974 and proudly served in the United States Coast Guard from 1976-1979. He returned to work at Sedillo Farms and SG Construction from 1979-1986. Later he attended New Mexico State University, Dona Ana Branch Community College, and Vocational Institute of NM, where he received his Bachelors of Arts from New Mexico Highlands University, Las Vegas, NM in 1991, he also received his Master of Arts from Ball State University, Muncie, IN in 1993. Lloyd taught technology/pre-engineering, drafting, woodworking, welding, construction, TV production, wrestling coach, and Spanish from 1993-2012. In his career he was honored with many awards such as Teacher of the Year from Ajo High School, AZ in 2009, program Excellence Award High School from Montgomery County Public Schools in 2000, Excellence teaching from the Chamber of Commerce, Frederick MD in 1996, Teacher of the Year from Frederick County Public Schools, CTE, MD also in 1996. He enjoyed traveling though 48 States as a truck driver from 2012-2018. Lloyd was is preceded in death by his parents, Jesus and Stella Chavez Sedillo; Brother, Bernie Sedillo, sisters, Pepa Gallegos and Ymelda H. Sedillo.
