Ira Rosie (Ashcroft) Morehouse of Los Lunas passed away peacefully on March 21st, 2019 at the age of 94. Mrs. Morehouse and her husband Glenn were musicians who were active in the New Mexico Old Time Fiddlers Association and helped organize and participate in Fiddle Contests across the Southwest. Ira taught herself to play the piano in her 60's to accompany Glenn's fiddle and other top notch musicians. Mrs. Morehouse grew up on a sheep ranch near Ramah, New Mexico during the Great Depression, a town partly settled by her Mormon pioneer ancestors during the late 1800's. Mrs. Morehouse enjoyed cooking, baking and tending to her beautiful flower garden. She was well known for her sense of humor and colorful life stories; making people laugh and smile everywhere she went. Mrs. Morehouse is preceded in death by husband Glenn Morehouse, parents Bertha and Wilford Ashcroft, and siblings Betty, Laverda, Ollie, Tony, and Rex. She is survived by her brother Earl Ashcroft of Mancos, CO, daughter Glenna Roberts and husband Chuck Roberts and grandson Dalton Roberts of Los Lunas, daughter Karen Kingston and Husband Alford Kingston of Los Chavez, grandson Justin Prieto and wife Blanca of Albuquerque, granddaughter Kristy Sweeney and husband Andrew Sweeney, and great grandchildren Glenn, Thomas, Ashly, Andrew, and Angie Lucy.
