My earliest memory of Fillimon was that when I was quite small we were thrashing wheat and we had a big pile of wheat straw and all of us kids were jumping in the straw after dark. I also remember my Dad invited Fillimon to go with us with a truck load of produce to sell to the Navajos on the Alamo Navajo Reservation.
