May 16, 1928 - February 25, 2023

Manforita (Peralta) Gallegos, age 94, a resident of Belen, NM, passed away on February 25, 2023, after a brief illness with her family by her side. Services will be held on Tuesday, March 7, 2023, at Our Lady of Belen Catholic Church. 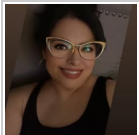

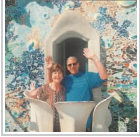
