Michael "Mikey" Sandoval, age 41, of Belen, NM, unexpectedly passed away due to Covid-19 on December 7, 2020.

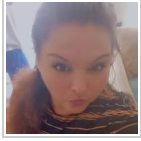

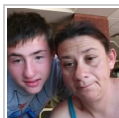
