It's with heavy hearts that we announce the sudden passing of our beloved Patrick Baca Jr., age 62, of Belen, NM. Patrick passed away with family and friends by his side on Sunday, June 28, 2015. He was born on August 15, 1952 in Honolulu, HI where his father was stationed at Pearl Harbor. He grew up in Socorro and graduated from Socorro High School in 1970. Patrick retired as a Colonel in the United States Air Force National Guard, where he served his country with great pride for 30 years. He had no greater joy in life than to raise his children and spoil his grandchildren. He and his wife were inseparable. They loved to fish, camp, participate in art shows, travel, spend time with family and enjoy life to the fullest without regret. Patrick was the best "Papa" his grandchildren could have asked for. "Who loves you?" "Papa does!!!" Patrick was preceded in death by his father Patrick Baca Sr., his father-in-law Salomon Trujillo, and his grandson Mateo David. 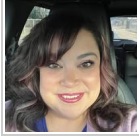

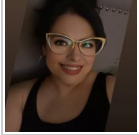
