July 11, 1947 - February 8, 2026

It is with deep sadness that we announce the passing of Prescilla Garcia Martinez, age 79, who passed away peacefully at her home in Peralta, New Mexico, on February 8, 2026, surrounded by family. A Rosary will take place on Wednesday, February 25, 2026, at 6:00 p.m., at Sangre de Cristo Catholic Church in Los Lunas, NM. A Visitation will take place on Thursday, February 26, 2026, at 10:00 a.m., followed by a Funeral Mass at 10:30 a.m. Interment will follow at Valencia Cemetery. Born on July 11, 1947, in Peralta to Frank P. Garcia and Carmel Garcia, Prescilla spent her early years in the community she loved and later attended high school in Los Lunas, NM. Prescilla worked as a bank processor, where she formed many lifelong friendships-relationships she always considered a true blessing. She also worked at Joe's Pharmacy and treasured the memories she made there. For more than twenty years, she served as caregiver to her niece, Monica, pouring her heart into caring for her and sharing countless moments of love and laughter. She was also an active member of the Our Lady of Guadalupe Parish Altar Society in Peralta.
