Regina Violet Ulibarri Chambers, age 54, a resident of Wichita Falls, TX., passed away Monday, February 19, 2018, following a long illness, with her family by her side. She was the sixth and last child of the late Preme and Margaret Ulibarri.

Regina was born at Belen General Hospital. She graduated from Belen High School in 1981. Regina participated in band, guitar club, cheerleading and dance team. She took piano lessons, ballet, tap, jazz, acrobatics and belonged to the Terpsica Dance Theater. Regina attended UNM and received a bachelor's degree in Elementary Education and minored in Music. She then received her master's degree in Education Administration in 1995 from NMSU.

Regina married James Chambers, an A-10 and F-16 USAF fighter pilot, and traveled the world and worked as a teacher in every location they lived. She had two children, James and Christine. Regina was a fun-loving person and she helped many students succeed and graduate from high school. She gave hope to the hopeless and many students would not have graduated without her love, support and dedication.

Regina is preceded in death by her parents, Preme and Margaret Ulibarri; her brother, Robert Ulibarri; her grandparents; her niece, Susanne; and other loved aunts, uncles and cousins.
