Our beloved Rupert Baca was called home to be with our Lord on Thursday, April 10, 2014 surrounded by his loving family. Rupert was born on November 14, 1928 in Belen, NM to the late Salomon and Nicomerez Baca. Rupert was a proud Veteran who served in the United States Army during the Korean Conflict. He served in the New Mexico National Guard as a Motor Pool Sergeant and Expert Marksman for 35 year until his retirement. He was a member of Our Lady of Belen Catholic Church where he participated in many ministries. He was Chairman of Our Lady of Belen Cemetery Council. He also served on the Fiesta Committee, Marriage Enrichment and taught religious education classes, and the Spanish choir. He was a member of the St. Mary's School Board, the Parish and Finance Counsel, La Gran Pastorela. He was also a longtime member of the Knights of Columbus, the Elk's Lodge, Mid Rio Grande Committee Action Program, Valencia County Foster Grandparents Program and a Scoutmaster. He was also well known for his role in the movie "Fools Rush In." He was preceded in death by his parents; his beloved first wife, Lourdes; son, Leonard; step-father, Antonio Benavidez; sister, Cecilia Otero; and brother, Edwin Benavidez. “ I would like to extend my condolences to the Baca Family. And ask that our Loving God send to your hearts comfort at this very difficult time.

While I know that Rupert Baca touched the lives of many people, I'd like to express just how much of a positive influence he was in my life. Rupert Baca was my Platoon Sergeant in the National Guard. He was a man that would not ask you to do something that he would not do himself. Rupert taught by example, letting you make mistakes and guiding you through the Consequences' of your mistakes so that you wouldn't do them again. And once that you understood what he was teaching you, he had a look on his face that you just knew he was pleased, otherwise if you were not catching on to what he was teaching, he would draw pictures, wither it was by story, or actual drawings on anything he could write on. Rupert later became my shooting coach in the National Guard Shooting Team. He taught me the concepts and the art, and science of shooting. He taught in the same manner of Mr. Miyagi from the Movie Karate Kid. I didn't realize I had learned to shoot the pistol from 25 and 50 yards until I made the 1984 National Guard Shooting Team. I had been taught to handle and shoot a pistol without bullets for most of my training. One day I got frustrated with Rupert, thinking I hadn't learned anything I had been practicing shooting a pistol without bullets. Rupert took me to the range, and told me to extend my arm (in competition you shoot with one arm extended) he said "front sight should be clear, rear sight slightly out of focus, and the target should be completely blurry." "Take in a breath, and as your exhale the trigger pull should be a surprise".....low and behold.....I shot a bull's eye. He said with a look on his face that showed he was pleased....."We'll continue practice tomorrow" I could not believe that I actually hit the bulls eye, I went on to represent New Mexico in the National Guard shooting team, with Rupert's consent teaching "You're here to make noise, not to win any competition, there will always be someone who will be shooting better." Only to discover a year later I had won many medals, trophies, and awards, Rupert being my coach kept them in a box saying "I guess I was wrong, you were much better

than they were” Rupert had taught me humility. I never understood why we left the shooting match before it was over.

Rupert Baca is a man in which Credibility, Integrity, and Honor, was his platform and touched many lives, and all who were bless to of known him have similar stories describing his charter He was my sergeant, my teacher, and mostly my friend. I know that when he crossed over to heaven, Rupert’s Master said to him, “Well done, my good and faithful servant”. The world will be different now. But heaven will be richer, and I became a better soldier, and a better person because of Rupert Baca. Good bye my dear friend, until we meet again.....
