Sara Sais-Valenzuela, age 105, a lifelong resident of Los Lunas, NM, passed into the arms of her Lord and Savior on Sunday, June 16, 2013. Sara was born to Pasqual and Aurelia Sais in Los Lentos, NM on September 9, 1907. She married Alifas Valenzuela in Isleta and they established their home and a thriving farm in Los Lentos. Sara later worked at the State Tuberculosis Sanitarium Hospital in Socorro, NM the State Hospital at Fort Stanton, NM and the State Hospital in Hagerman, NM. She returned to Los Lunas and was employed by the Los Lunas Hospital and Training School. Sara was the first woman hired as a "Grandmother" for residents of the training school. She found particular joy and blessings in caring for these special children. She was preceded in death by her parents, Pasqual Sais and Aurelia Jaramillo-Sais; her husband, Alifas Valenzuela; her twin sister, Gavina; brothers, Ricardo, Celedon, Silverio, J. Solomon and Rosendo Sais; and son-in-law, Joe V. Aragon. Sara is survived by her daughter, Aurelia Aragon; sister, Stella Phillips; special niece, Edwina Martinez; grandsons, Joseph R. Aragon and wife, Nilda, Jack LM Aragon and wife, Carol; great-grandchildren, Joseph R. II and wife, Kim, Justin, Ryan, Briana, Franchelle, Fernando and Felicia Aragon; great-great-grandchildren, Isabel, Emelia and Thalia Aragon; all her loving care takers of many years. She is also survived by many loving nieces and nephews who were blessed with a wonderful and loving aunt. "She was a mom, grandma, granny and tia to so many of us." All services will be held at San Clemente Parish, beginning with a viewing on Tuesday, June 18, at 7:30 p.m. with a rosary to be recited at 8:00 p.m. A final visitation will be held on Wednesday, June 19, at 9:30 a.m. with a Funeral Mass to be celebrated at 10:00 a.m. Interment will follow at Los Lentos Catholic Cemetery. 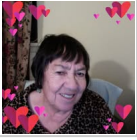
