She taught us how to battle when all was against her, she taught us kindness in her darkest moments, she taught us all how strong love really is. Terry's faith was very strong; she didn't fear death; she was ready to go if that was God's plan. She continued to believe and pray for others all the way through her last days.

She is survived by her husband, Ramon Molina; children, De'jah, Dionne, D'ezrah, Israel; granddaughter, Brielle; mother, Martha Felix-Garcia; and sister, Anissa Garcia.
