Vicky Rae Anderson, daughter of Dawn and husband, Glenn Callander and the late Raymond Anderson, passed away at her home Monday, July 14, 2014. She was born June 15, 1955 in Mora, Minnesota, the oldest of four children. She was baptized and later confirmed in the Missouri Synod Lutheran Church. She attended school in Illinois, Minnesota, California and Nebraska, graduating in 1973 from Hayes County High School, Hayes Center, NE. She attended school at Midland Lutheran College in Fremont, NE. After working a few years, she joined the Air Force. She excelled in the service and was Airman of the Year in 1984. She was honorably discharged for health reasons, but continued to serve her country as a contractor for the Air Force. Her failing health caused her to retire in 2009. She was preceded in death by her father, Raymond Anderson; sister, Paula Shane; and nephew, Ian Shane. Vicky is survived by her parents, Dawn and husband, Glenn Callander; brother, Dan V.
