Warren O. F. Harris, age 76, a resident of Bosque, NM, left us to join his wife, Rose Marie Tapia Harris in their final resting place. Warren was the son of Dr. Owen and Eleanor Harris. He completed Law School at the University of New Mexico. Warren served as the attorney for the NM Livestock Board, NM Director of Enforcement for the Security Division, Chief Deputy District Attorney for the 13th Judicial District and he retired as a Senior Trial Prosecutor for the 2nd Judicial District. He served on the Board of Directors for Santa Gertrudis Breeders International. Warren's loves were his wife, his family, and his cattle. He is survived by his sister, Patricia, and brother-in-law, Roger Logenbach; in-laws, the Tapia family from Santa Fe, his adopted Sanchez Family, many nieces, nephews and adopted family members.
